it is a legal requirement for us to have an updated immunization record. We can only accept the copy of the record derived from Medicare Website.





Recipe of the month

Mexican pasta salad

Ingredients

- 250g wholemeal pasta, cooked e.g. spirals or penne
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- ½ red capsicum, diced
- ½ red onion, finely diced
- 1 Lebanese cucumber, diced
- 400g tin corn kernels, drained
- 400g tin black beans, drained & rinsed
- 1/4 cup fresh coriander, chopped

Dressing

- 1/4 cup reduced fat plain yoghurt
- ¼ cup mayonnaise
- 1 lemon, juiced
- 1/4 tsp ground cumin

Method:

Combine all the salad ingredients in a large bowl.

Mix all the dressing ingredients in a small bowl. Add the dressing to the salad and toss gently to combine.
